Module 1

Preventing litigation

- Principles of public contract procurement.
- Contractual documents of the contracts: technical specifications, special conditions, specifications, general administrative terms and conditions, bill of quantities, breakdown of costs and quantities, technical drawings and documents.

- Contractual obligations of the owner and of the contract holder, and performance guarantees.
